





## TEXAS TWO-STEP

Coyote's cone 10 "Oil Spot" glazes have provided some of the most striking and unique finishes in ceramics. Now, these Texas Two-Step glazes provide the same sought-after effect at cone 6, in a breathtaking variety of color combinations. These glazes work as a two part system, with the top coat pulling away to reveal brilliant spots of the glaze beneath.







You can see the Two-Step series below, with five of the overcoat/undercoat combinations shown. To use the Texas Two Step glazes, simply apply a Step One Undercoat to bisque ware (two or three coats brushing or one coat dipped) and wait for it to dry completely. Then, cover all or part of the first color with your choice of Step Two Overcoat. When the piece is fired to cone 6 in an electric kiln, the glazes will interact, creating a phenomenal oil spot effect.

Varying the thickness of the glazes during application will have a dramatic effect on the finished piece, as the thicker the glazes get, the larger the spots they create will be. We found that the optimum thickness should be two coats of the Step One Undercoat and three coats of the Step Two Overcoat, but you may prefer thicker or thinner applications for different effects. Try experimenting!

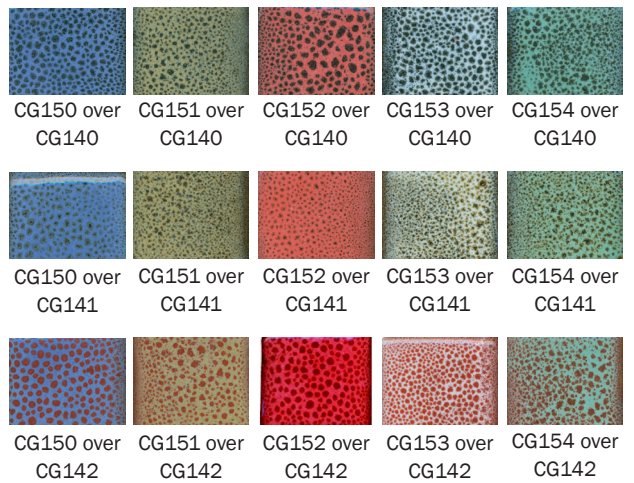
